The Safe Beds Program

We provide Mental Health Crisis and Withdrawal Management Services to individuals 16 years of age and up who:

- are in or nearing a mental health and/or substance use crisis including intoxication;
- need a safe 24/7 living environment and help with mental health crisis, detox services, drug replacement, anti-craving help;
- need immediate care and support;
- do not require hospitalization
- have been or are about to be charged by police.

The Safe Beds Team

Through a person-centered approach, services and supports are provided by a team of Therapists, Nurses, Physicians, Psychiatrists and Support Staff.

Team members will work together with you to help you get through your immediate crisis and begin a care plan according to your needs and choices.

This can include:

- care, counselling and personal support;
- drug replacement therapy, anticraving medications, or helping you decrease your medication;
- referrals to services and support to help you stay out of crisis and work towards recovery.
